## MAIT Mobile Alcohol Intervention Team

The initiative's aim is to engage with young people under-16 out on the streets who are under the influence or in possession of alcohol.

An alcohol brief intervention including a FAST/CRAFT assessment of their alcohol use will be offered. Clued Up then does a follow up with the young people who have engaged in MAIT when a fuller assessment of their needs is undertaken. Currently the MAIT mobile unit can be found out on the streets on rotating Friday nights between 6pm and 10pm in the Kirkcaldy, Levenmouth, West Fife and Dunfermline areas.



## YPG

The YPG participated in 2 days of team building activities at Lochore Meadows, which everyone enjoyed. The activities included, canoeing, making a campfire and cooking sausages on the island. They also went rock climbing and abseiling in Crieff. The activities really helped the group to challenge themselves and get to know each other better.

## Levenmouth Bike Group

This is a collaborative project involving Clued Up, Levenmouth CLD and Education. The group of young people have been biking since February and have just started using road bikes. The group aim to undertake a journey in late August/September. This journey will be around 150 -200 miles. After the project is complete, the road bikes will remain in Levenmouth for use by the community.



## Fife Outreach Service

Our young people outreach and support service run in partnership with Barnardos, works with vulnerable young people 12 to 18 years old affected by substance use on a one to one basis and tailored group work programmes.



## Graffiti Project



Clued Up and Fife Council CLD teamed up to work on the Birnam Road Road Project in the Templehall area of Kirkcaldy. Young people worked hard to give the mural a facelift and they came up with a colourful design which has brightened up the area. It was funded by Fife Council's Local Planning budget. Contributions were also made by Dulux, Thomas McKee from Cameleon Decorators and Kerry Wilson (artist).

## Drinkaware Group

Between January and March we worked with a group of S4's from Woodmill High School. They produced a short film and an interactive quiz designed as part of the alcohol section of the Clued Up App. The project follows on from work undertaken in Dunfermline High School last year and was run in partnership with CLD and Police Scotland. We devised the programme in response to requests from both the school and concerns raised in the local community about alcohol consumption amongst young people in the Duloch area. The participants worked really hard and have produced some great work. They will be receiving Asdan awards in the next few weeks once the editing is complete .

Since moving into our new premises at 441 High Street, Kirkcaldy KY1 2SN, we are now in a position to offer rooms for hire. Please contact us for more info.

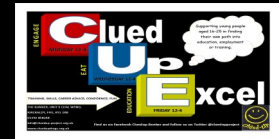


**Large meeting room/training room suitable for group work.**
