





# Travel Directions

## By Car

Clicking on the name of a route below will take you to Google Maps directions that can be used for satellite navigation.

### Approaching from the Queensferry Crossing (around 20 minutes)

Follow the M90 north.

At Junction 2A, use the left two lanes to take the A92 exit towards Kirkcaldy/Glenrothes.

Continue along this road for around 7.5 miles.

Take the A910/B981 exit towards Kirkcaldy West/Cardenden.


At the first roundabout, take the 2nd exit (straight on), and then at the next roundabout take the third exit (right) onto the A910 (Wester Bogie Road).

Continue along Wester Bogie Road for around 2.5 miles.

At the next roundabout, take the 2nd exit (straight on) on to Whyte Melville Road. Follow this road for around 0.2 miles, then turn left onto Abbotshall Road.

Take the first right onto East Fergus Place and continue for around 350 ft. Our office will be on your right hand side.

## Approaching from the Kincardine Bridge (around 40 minutes)

Follow the A985 east.

Continue along the A985 for around 13.5 miles passing through seven roundabouts as follows:

1st: second exit (*straight on*)

2nd: third exit (*straight on*)

3rd: second exit (*straight on*)

4th: second exit (*straight on*)

5th: third exit (*straight on*)

At the large roundabout, follow the A921.

At the first roundabout, take the first exit (left), and then at the next roundabout (immediately afterwards), take the second exit (right) onto the A921.

Continue on for around 1 mile and then take the 2nd exit (straight on) at the next roundabout. Continue on for 2 miles, and then take the 1st exit at the next roundabout onto the B9157.

Continue for around 8 miles.

Turn left onto B9157 (Bridge Street) and continue for around 0.8 miles. At the first roundabout, take the 2nd exit, then take the 2nd exit at the mini-roundabout onto Abbotshall Road.

Continue for 0.1 miles, then turn right onto East Fergus Place.

Follow Abbotshall Road for around 0.1 miles.

Take the first right onto East Fergus Place and continue for around 350 ft. Our office will be on your right-hand side.

## Approaching from the Tay Bridge (about 45 minutes)

At the roundabout, take the second exit (straight on) and follow the A92 south.

Continue along the A92 for around 24 miles passing through five roundabouts, taking the second exit (straight on) at each.

At the next roundabout, take the 3rd exit (straight on) and continue on the A92. Continue for 1 mile, then take the 3rd exit (straight on) at the Bankhead roundabout.

Continue for around 2.7 miles, then take the first exit (slight left) at the next roundabout onto the A921. Take the 2nd exit (straight on) at the next roundabout.

Continue along the A921 for around 1.1 miles. Turning right onto Millie Street.

Continue for around 1.5 miles as the road becomes Victoria Road, then Bennoch Road.

Turn right onto Abbotshall Road, then after around 500 ft take the first left onto East Fergus Place.

Continue for around 350ft. Our office will be on your right-hand side.

### Parking

We have a limited amount of parking available for disabled users only in a private car park adjacent to the office building. There are designated bays available for disabled users. Users of this car park must book their spaces in advance and register at reception. Any cars parked without prior authorisation will be subject to ticketing and liable to receive a fine.

**Alternative parking is available, free of charge, at Kirkcaldy Railway Station.**

### East Coast Main Line to/from Aberdeen/Dundee/Edinburgh

Fife Circle Line to/from Edinburgh/Kirkcaldy/Dunfermline/  
Cowdenbeath

#### Kirkcaldy Railway Station is a 5-minute walk from our office

Exit the train station by the main door (if alighting from Platform 1), or through the underpass (if alighting from Platform 2).

Take the path immediately in front of you and turn right (just at the sign for Kirkcaldy Galleries). Follow the path downhill through the park to Abbotshall Road.

Cross the road at the nearby lights and turn right to continue along Abbotshall Road.

Turn left onto East Fergus Place and continue walking for 1 - 2 minutes. Our office will be on your left-hand side.

*A taxi takes around 2-3 minutes and normally costs around £3 - £4*

## By Bus

Kirkcaldy Bus Station is a 5-minute walk from our office, and is served by a large number of routes throughout Fife, and connecting at Glenrothes for services to Dundee, Edinburgh, Glasgow and Stirling.

Exit the Bus Station (all stances) onto Hunger Place and turn left.

Take the first right onto Whytescauseway and continue straight for 2 - 3 minutes as the road becomes East Fergus Place. Our office will be on your right-hand side.

### Buses serving Kirkcaldy Bus Station

Clicking on the name of a stance opposite will take you to Stagecoach's live tracker for that stance. Clicking on a route number will take you to a PDF version of the timetable, hosted by Stagecoach.

Other bus options, as well as maps of bus routes and a journey planner, can be found on the Stagecoach website.
